

How to connect your digital keyboard to your iPad:

1. Purchase the USB adapter for your iPad. It used to be called the “Camera Connector kit”, but now you can just ask for a USB adapter for the iPad. It should look like one of these, depending on the iPad you own:

iPad 2, 3, 4:



iPad Air:



2. Purchase a MIDI adapter. These are most easily found in a musical instrument store or online at Amazon or other sellers. To find the correct adapter, you need to look at your digital keyboard. There are two types of connections. Here is what they look like, followed by what interface you need:

If your keyboard has something like this, it has Traditional MIDI connections:



You need to purchase an interface that has USB on one end and two MIDI connections on the other end. They will look similar to this:

If your keyboard has something like this, it is newer:



You need this type of cable (most often called a USB printer cable):
